Asset Manager Integration

Last Spring, we released the new version of the OAKLAND Scale Manager. The new version connects to the Asset Manager and Agronomy Manager modules of the OAKLAND System which allows you to:

- Search for NH3 tanks and other equipment
- Attach secondary equipment like tool-bars
- Add secondary products and charges
- Apply the weights to blend sheets or customer billing groups
- Import tickets directly into billing
- Transfer scale tickets between locations

The latest feature allows for ticket transfers from one location to another. NH3 tanks and other equipment that are weighed-out of one location and returned to another can complicate ticket workflows. OAKLAND Scale Manager simplifies this process by allowing the scale operator to lookup and transfer a scale ticket from a remote location.

Once transferred, the equipment is weighed-in using the same process for other ticket workflows. While billing tickets, the OAKLAND System indicates the originating location for transferred scale tickets. This allows the user to decide which inventory to bill from or if location inventory transfers are appropriate.

Upgrading or Adding Outdoor Printers

Over the last year, we've noticed an increase in scale facilities adding or updating outdoor printers. If you are currently upgrading or adding an outdoor printer, please consider purchasing a printer with ethernet capability. Ethernet communication is the modern replacement for serial based communication.

Many existing remote printer installations are serial based, but adding an ethernet connection and printer can be an inexpensive upgrade which gives you modern capabilities. Ethernet printers are much easier to troubleshoot and less prone to lightning strike failures.

Printer administration websites help determine printer status, like out of paper warnings and other issues. Switching to ethernet also eliminates a serial connection to the scale computer and can support the new OAKLAND Scale Ticket Templates.

The OAKLAND Scale Manager supports a variety of scale ticket paper sizes and template designs. Scale tickets can have logos, grids and other visual items printed on the ticket.

OAKLAND Scale Ticket Templates are designed to be quickly scanned by the grower or driver to immediately identify information like bushel totals, moisture content, and other information. Federal or state required terms and/or other information can be displayed using smaller fonts to be less distracting but still meet requirements.

OAKLAND to Excel Workflow

The OAKLAND Report Notifications App speeds up the process of exporting data to Microsoft Excel or other spreadsheet applications. The previous solution to export data to Excel was a slow process which tied up your Oakland Application and Excel until the export was complete.

Our new export streamlines this process, giving you less time waiting and more time to be productive. Exporting thousands of rows takes only seconds instead of minutes or hours. This is a great time saving feature that speeds up the workflow of OAKLAND to *Microsoft Excel*.



The new export also retains the formatting of the original data, allowing you to make decisions how the data should be formatted. The following are some examples:

- Leading zero numbers like account numbers and other codes are retained

Example: "00013486" is not converted to "13486"

- Data resembling dates like General Ledger Codes are retained

Example: "02-01" is not converted to "2/1/2018"

- UPC codes and other 12 or more digits codes are not converted to scientific notation

Example: "812304579103" is not converted to "8.12305E+11"

Automated Fuel Manager Degree Day

OAKLAND Fuel Manager provides multiple input methods for degree days (single day, running total, or high/low temperature). The choice between degree day and frequency is configurable by the tank. Degree day information can be entered manually or data can be automatically downloaded.

Each night, after local weather stations at airports or schools, report their final temperature readings for the day, our automated process requests this degree day value and inputs it into OAKLAND Fuel Manager – always accurate and entirely hassle-free. It runs over weekends, holidays, and even catches up on its own should a weather station take longer than usual to post its official temperatures.
