

## iPhone or iPod touch

From the home screen, choose "Settings", then "Mail, Contacts, Calendars", then "Add Account..."  
You will see an Exchange option at the top of the list. (Figure 1)

Select this option and you will be asked to provide your email address, Username and Password, and a description of the account. (Figure 2)

Email: <full email address>

Username: <full email address>

Password: <your password>

After completing all fields and clicking the 'next' option, the device will attempt to locate a server, however this process will not succeed. At this point you will be provided with a similar dialog that now asks for your server address. This should be 'mail.oaklandcorp.com' (Figure 3)

Once the iPhone has confirmed connectivity with your Kerio MailServer, you will be asked which type of folders to synchronize. By default Email, Contacts, and Calendars are selected. (Figure 4, 5, 6)

Once you save this information, the device will begin to synchronize. You can go back into the account settings to configure additional options, such as the number of days for synchronization, or SSL.
